Founded in 1911 Duntroon is one of the only military bases in Australia that is open to the public. One of the oldest homesteads in Canberra, Duntroon House was built in 1833 by landowner Robert Campbell. It was originally a sheep station and is a picture-book example of early Australian architecture. The original house was single storey and built in the traditional colonial style. In 1862 an extension, including a second storey, was added. The house now serves as the Officer's Mess at the Royal Military College. Duntroon House and gardens will be open for members and guests to explore.
